

Scripture Readings (ESV):

Acts 3:12-19:

¹² And when Peter saw it he addressed the people: "Men of Israel, why do you wonder at this, or why do you stare at us, as though by our own power or piety we have made him walk? ¹³ The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His servant Jesus, whom you delivered over and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he had decided to release Him. ¹⁴ But you denied the Holy and Righteous One, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, ¹⁵ and you killed the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses. ¹⁶ And His name—by faith in His name—has made this man strong whom you see and know, and the faith that is through Jesus has given the man this perfect health in the presence of you all.

¹⁷ "And now, brothers, I know that you acted in ignorance, as did also your rulers. ¹⁸ But what God foretold by the mouth of all the prophets, that His Christ would suffer, He thus fulfilled. ¹⁹ Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out."

Matthew 15:21-28:

²¹ And Jesus went away from there and withdrew to the district of Tyre and Sidon. ²² And behold, a Canaanite woman from that region came out and was crying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David; my daughter is severely oppressed by a demon." ²³ But He did not answer her a word. And His disciples came and begged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she is crying out after us." ²⁴ He answered, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." ²⁵ But she came and knelt before Him, saying, "Lord, help me." ²⁶ And He answered, "It is not right to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs." ²⁷ She said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their masters' table." ²⁸ Then Jesus answered her, "O woman, great is your faith! Be it done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed instantly.

Scripture: Acts 3:12-19; Matthew 15:21-28

1.	Sermon: Good Morning, Saints of St. John's! In our call to worship (Psalm 4:3), we heard how God sets the godly apart for Himself. How do you see God doing that in your life and in the life of the Church?
2.	How did God use the healing of the lame beggar to bring people to a place of repentance and refreshment (Acts 3:19)? How do you emulate Peter's action of giving people another chance to repent?
3.	How do Jesus' words in Matthew 15:24 & 26 comfort you and challenge you? How do you apply those words in your teaching and sharing of the Gospel of Jesus Christ?
4.	How do the teachings of limited atonement and definite redemption empower you? Do you understand your particular calling and ministry and service for the kingdom, in this church, and to this community? How do you live that out daily?

Entering the Church: Please continue to enter from the South and East entrance as the North door does not close properly.


